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Introduction

Along with the development and integration process of the Vietnamese economy in general and the National Economics University – a leading university in the country - in particular, the Faculty of Economics was established by Decision No. 3261/QĐ-BGD & DT-TCCB 22 July 2002 by the Minister of Education and training to teach Economics for all levels of students at the university, including Undergraduate, Master and Doctoral levels. From Intake 48 in 2006, the Faculty of Economics started to train bachelors specialized in Economics with the goal is to train bachelors with political qualities, good health and moral, and had mastered the basic economic and social knowledge, as well as in-depth study on the subject of economics, processed the skills to analyze the activities of the economy, evaluate the impact of economic policies, participate in economic forecasting and contributing in policy making. After graduation, the students showed good capacity for scientific research as well as working in businesses. Many students achieved the top prize at the School, the Ministry level for scientific research. Many employed in important positions in the government agencies, research institutes and enterprises.

Aside from the training objective, regarding scientific research, the lecturers from the Faculty of Economics has chaired and participated in many scientific research projects at all level including State, Ministry and University level. These projects had made useful contribution in the field of Macro and Micro-economics. Supporting the development of economic policies by the government during each stage of the development process.

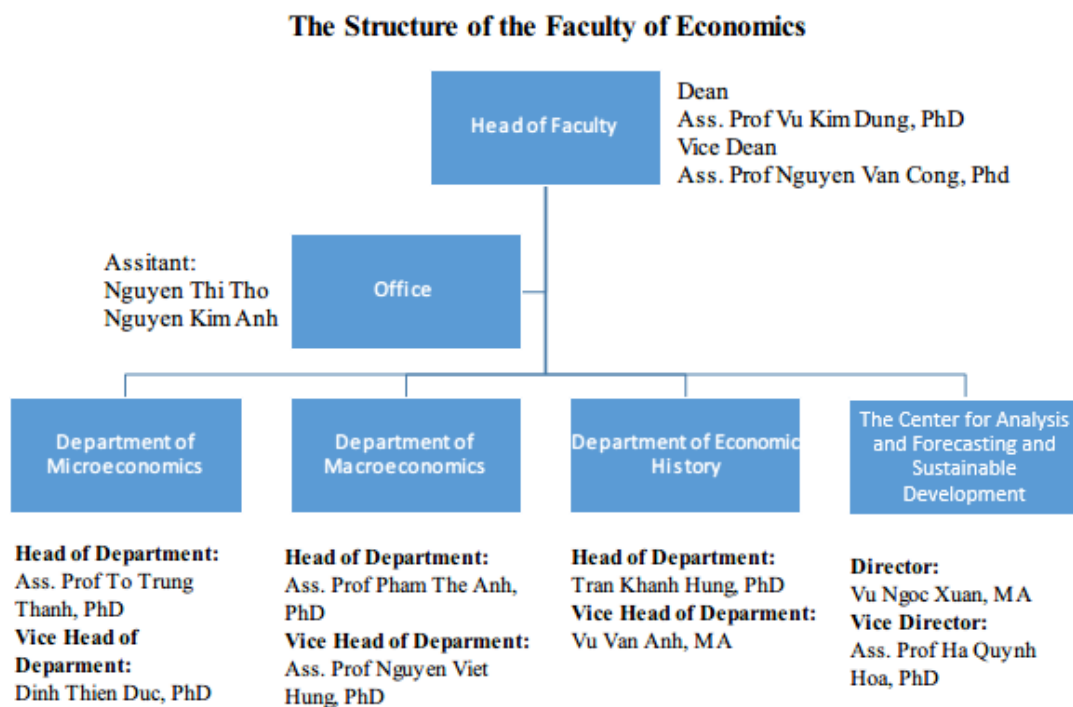
Function

- ▶ Teaching the subjects of Economics (including Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Economy of Vietnam and Economic History) to all levels of students in the university. Of which, Microeconomics I and Macroeconomic I are required subjects that all undergraduate students have to complete.
- ▶ Training bachelors, masters and doctoral students that specialized in Economics. Creating and maintaining the syllabus for Economics students with in-depth as well as updated subjects, to ensure the high-standard of

education.

- ▶ Taking part in scientific research, chair and participate in scientific research projects at all levels, write for academic journals in Vietnam as well as at the international levels.
- ▶ Other administrative tasks as required by the university.
- ▶ The Center for Analysis and Forecasting and Sustainable Development under the Faculty perform functions such as the implementation of the consultancy contracts regarding data analysis and forecasting. The Center also organizing short training courses on economics, data analysis and the use of special software for the analysis of economic activities.

Faculty Structure and Staff



The Faculty of Economics comprised of 3 Departments and the Center for Analysis and Forecasting and Sustainable Development. From inception to date, the Faculty of Economics had 43 faculty members, 2 managing officers. The quality of the faculty is constantly rising with 8 associate professors, 18 PhDs and 18 Masters. Many lecturers received postgraduate education in the countries with the most advanced levels of education such as the UK, US, Australia. Faculty members are currently involved in teaching many courses for all three levels of training, including high-quality and advanced programs.

Faculty Achievements

Faculty of Economics is the best address to learn and to do basic research in economics. Faculty has very good lecturers and researchers who have graduated from the best universities in the United State of America, United Kingdom, Japan and other countries. Lecturers of the faculty can use English perfectly in teaching and doing research. Faculty has published many books on economics which are widely used by other universities in Vietnam. Faculty of Economics is playing important role in training economics lecturers for other universities. Faculty and faculty members were awarded many prizes from the universities, the ministry and the government for the contribution in the field of training and economic advisory service.

 - Subjects for students specialized in Economics: Microeconomics Analysis I and II, Macroeconomics Analysis I and II, Modern Issues in Macroeconomics, Modern Issues in Microeconomics, Applied Econometrics I and II, Economics of Social Issues, Economics of Government Budget, Economics of Government Spending, Economics of Development.

 - Advanced Microeconomics, Advanced Macroeconomics
 - Managerial Economics
- ▶ Subjects for doctoral study:
 - Issues in Economics

Maintain the syllabus for bachelor, master and doctoral students specialized in economics. For the last 10 years: The Faculty has trained over 500 bachelors from intake 48 to 57 and hundreds of graduate and doctoral students from Intake 5 to 24.

- ▶ Scientific Research:
 - Members of the Faculty had complete the text books for the subject in the program, including the new Economic textbook to celebrate 55 years of

the National Economics University. Many reference books to complement the studies have been published.

- Members of the Faculty have chaired and participated in many scientific research projects at all level including State, Ministry and University level. During the last 10 years, the faculty had 3 state-level projects, 9 ministry-level projects and many university-level projects chaired by its members. Along with them are many journal articles in national and international economics journals, members of the faculty always completed the requirement from the university regarding the research goal of a lecturers.
