

Faculty of Management Science

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Introduction

Founded in 1977, the Faculty of Management Science has a long history of training, research and consulting in management and policy. After nearly 40 years of development, the Faculty of Management Science has positively contributed to training managers, researchers, consultants, policy makers and policy analysts for central and local state agencies, enterprises and socio-economic organizations.

History

- ▶ 1977: Establishment of the Department of Management Science (the predecessor of the Faculty of Management Science) by Decision No. 203/TC dated December 12, 1977
- ▶ 1996: Establishment of the Faculty of Management Science under Decision No 1561/GD-ĐT of the Ministry of Education and Training by April 16, 1996.

Functions

Being a training unit of the National Economics University, the Faculty of Management Science has functions and duties that are defined in the Regulations on Organization and Operation of the National Economics University issued under Decision No. 1723/QĐ-ĐHKQTĐ-TCCB dated November 11, 2010. The Faculty of Management Science's functions and duties are defined as follows:

1. Propose changes in structure and personnel; register to the University to undertake training at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, open specialties and sub-specialties;
2. Develop training programs, teaching plans, lead the organization of training as following:
 - ▶ Bachelor programs in: Economic management; Public management; Public

management and policy in English

- ▶ Master programs in: Economic management and policy; Public management
- ▶ Doctor programs in: Economic management; Public management
- ▶ Short-course training in: Economic management; Public management; Public policy; and soft skills in those field

We also organize the training and other educational activities of the University's training program and plans;

3. Seek partners and develop joint-training programs at undergraduate and postgraduate levels;

4. Make plans to develop lecturers, training programs and standard facilities, ensure the quality, meet social needs and international integration;

5. Organize scientific and technological activities; actively exploit international cooperation projects; collaborate with scientific and technological institutions and production facilities and business, link training and scientific research, production, business and the society;

6. Provide policy advice and consultancy services for businesses, state bodies, public organizations; organize short-term training courses as regulated by the University;

7. Manage lectures, staffs and students of the Faculty as assigned by the Rector;

8. Manage the training content, methods and quality; manage the quality of scientific and technological activities;

9. Organize the compilation of training programs and textbooks assigned by the Rector; improve teaching and learning methods;

10. Develop plans and organize the work of political education, ideology, morals for lecturers, staffs and learners; organize training and coaching professional qualifications for the faculty lecturers and staffs;


11. Evaluate the Faculty management staff, lecturers and researchers; evaluate upper management staff and those across the NEU as regulated by the University;

12. Perform other duties as assigned by the Rector.

People

Faculty structure, lecturers and staff

The Faculty consists of three academic departments: Economic Management, Social Management, Technology Management and one Center for Training, Research and Management Consultancy.



Our full time academic staff graduated from globally-recognized universities and the vast majority are associate professors and doctors in the field of economics and management. All the academic staff members have extensive teaching and professional experience and carry out substantial research work.

Activities

The Faculty provides academic programs at the undergraduate and graduate levels.

At the undergraduate level, we offer two Bachelor's degrees taught in Vietnamese – Bachelor of Economic Management and Bachelor of Public Management – and one Bachelor's degree taught in English – Bachelor of Public Management and Policy.

At the postgraduate level, the Faculty offers both a Master of research and Master of course work in Economic Management & Policy and Public Management. We have been training PhDs since 1980 (intake I) and currently we are providing two PhD programs in Management Science and Public Management.

Bachelor of Economic Management

- Started in 1994, the program aims at training professional managers and consultants in the fields of economic management and policy. The program is taught in Vietnamese.
- Students are equipped with fundamental knowledge and skills in economics and management.

Bachelor of Public Management

- Started in 2006, this program was designed based on current public management curricula at globally-recognized universities. The program is taught in Vietnamese.
- Students are equipped with foundational and up-to-date knowledge in public management, necessary skills and attitudes for professional public managers.

Bachelor of Public management and Policy in English

- This is a high quality undergraduate program taught entirely in English, which equips students with skills and attitudes necessary for professional public managers.
- All core courses are conducted in English by local and foreign professors.
- Degree is awarded by the National Economics University.

Master in Economic Management and Policy

- This program is designed to provide a broad understanding and necessary skills for economic managers and policy analysts to work creatively and efficiently. The program is delivered in Vietnamese.
- Students may choose either full-time (1.5-year) or part-time (2-year) programs.

Master in Public Management

- This program is designed based on current public management curricula at globally-recognized universities in the USA and the UK and oriented to a Vietnamese context.
- The program focuses on the development and strengthening of skills and attitudes relevant to solving public problems.
- Students may choose either full-time (1.5-year) or part-time (2-year) programs.

Doctoral Program

- The Faculty provides a PhD in Economics with two majors: (i) *Economic Management*, and (ii) *Public Management*.
- We prepare the next generation of leading management researchers with a focus on conducting research and developing management theories.
- PhD candidates are equipped with broad and thorough knowledge in management and research skills that are necessary for publishing research works in leading national, regional and international journals.
- PhD students may choose either full-time (3-year) or part-time (4-year) programs.

Over the last 40 years, apart from training, the Faculty of Management Science has had a variety of scientific research projects at Ministry and University levels and participated in scientific research projects at the State level. Hundreds of articles

authored by the Faculty's lecturers have been published in professional journals and at national and international scientific conferences. Dozens of textbooks and books authored by the Faculty's lecturers have also been published.
